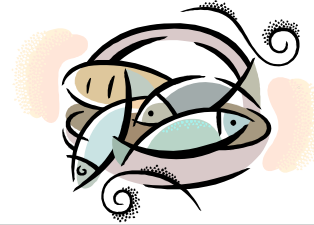

Finance At the DCC meeting in January the accounts for 2011 were presented showing a profit of just over £2000. This profit was due to the lower amount of Parish share we had to pay & enabled us to pay all our bills by the end of December. Our thanks go to all who gave money to this church last year.

The 2012 forecast is not so good in that it shows a higher figure for the Parish share of £35546 and therefore together with other costs including insurance, heat & light, the cost of running this church for this year is estimated at £45000 (£125 per day). This means that, based on our current giving, this would give a loss for 2012 of £4646 (just under £13 per day). This is without any money set aside for work on the outside roof of the church which is currently being looked at and the inside plastering which will need replacing later this year.

In order to help to meet our 2012 expenditure there will be a gift day held in April this year. This will be an opportunity for us to 1. review our current giving or 2. make a donation. Please remember if you are a taxpayer to complete a Gift Aid form and give to either Linda or David Wakeling.
